NEW's pre-apprenticeship training programs lead graduates to careers that pay considerably more than jobs traditionally held by women entering the workplace. NEW graduates have access to high-paying jobs with benefits.

At NEW, we train women for union jobs that offer paid training throughout the apprenticeship period and substantial benefit packages, including health insurance, pensions, sick leave, and the opportunity for further education.

Q: Who is eligible for NEW's free program?

A: Women who are at least 18 years old, have a high school diploma or GED, and are able to perform physical work and lift at least 50 lbs. To qualify for NEW's six-week training you must complete an entrance assessment.

Gain Hands-on Skills

Each year, we offer hundreds of women a free, six-week pre-apprenticeship training program that provides them with the basic skills and knowledge to begin work in the construction, facilities maintenance, transportation, green, and energy industries.

NEW's training programs and services include:

- Hands-on shop skills
- Classroom instruction
- Job placement assistance
- Support services, including referrals to childcare and housing and legal assistance

Q: What is NEW's training schedule?

A: NEW offers free six-week pre-apprenticeship programs with day and evening classes available.
