Therapeutic Group for Young Adults Transitioning to Independent Living

The group is a weekly discussion/support group for young adults who are preparing to exit the foster care system. This group provides an opportunity for transitioning youth to process their experiences in a non-judgmental, supportive environment with peers who have similar challenges. The purpose of this group is to provide a forum for these individuals to talk about their hopes, fears and expectations about independent living and to facilitate a conversation about what is needed to succeed as an independent adult.

The group is a weekly, one-hour commitment and runs for approximately 14 weeks.

Eligibility: Adolescents (ages 18-21) who are aging out of foster care.
